Provided services

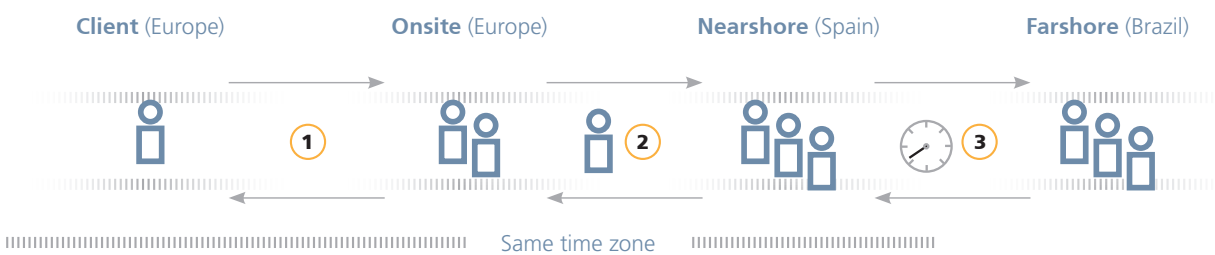
